REASON FOR NEW VOTE AND CONSULTATION SESSION

On October 16, 2024, a majority of the Members of Apitipi Anicinapek Nation voted in favour of and thus ratified the Election Atci Okimake Inakonike8in (Law).

Unfortunately, a quorum of Council has refused to endorse this vote and order the Law into force. This has created a legal vacuum that has to be fixed. We have to be able to proceed in an election in a reasonable time under a set of rules that are known to apply.

As a result, the Election Atci Okimake Inakonike8in (Law) has been changed to ensure that Council does not need to confirm a community vote and to ensure that no deadlocks or impasses can occur (there are backup decision-makers that will prevent this).

The Law is new in the highlighted sections. Please pay attention to those.
